BBUUC Proxy voting policy for 2023 Annual meeting

This policy must be followed for all proxies used at BBUUC meetings of the membership.

- 1. No individual may vote more than 3 proxies at any meeting.
- 2. Proxies must be submitted in one of the following ways:
 - a. By filling out the online proxy form Click for Form
 - b. By email, sent to proxy@bbuuc.org
 - c. In writing, dropped off in the office.
- 3. Proxies must be received 3 days in advance.
- 4. Proxies count toward quorum.
- 5. Proxies must indicate:
 - a. Name of member that is unable to attend.
 - b. Name of member that will vote the proxy.
- 6. Proxies are only valid for a single meeting.
- 7. A list of members voting by proxy and the member holding their vote can be made public during the meeting.
- 8. A voting card will be given for each proxy to the holder.
- 9. The proxy holder can vote any way they want.
- 10. If the proxy holder does not attend the meeting or leaves before it is adjourned, the proxies will be given to a different member.
